FIRST LEG

- From the parking lot take the mall circumference road to Fair Lakes Parkway.
- Follow Fair Lakes Parkway to Fairfax County Parkway. *1.7 mi*
- Turn left on Fairfax County Parkway.
- Exit Parkway at Route 29. Head south on Route 29. *1.6 mi*
- Proceed south on US 29 past Route 28 and I-66 interchanges.
- Turn left onto Bull Run Post Office Road. *5.7 mi*
- Follow Bull Run Post Office Road until it turns sharply left. *1.1 mi*
- Turn left at sharp bend onto Compton Road.
- Follow Compton Road and cross Centerville Road (Rte 28) to Union Mill Road. *4.6 mi*
- Stay on Compton Road through the Union Mill Road intersection. Look for the Card Stop.

SECOND LEG

- Follow Compton Road to Clifton Road. *2.0 mi*
- Turn right on Clifton Road and proceed into Clifton.
- Proceed through Clifton on Main Street.
- Continue on Main Street until it turns into Kincheloe Road at the fork in the road at Dell Avenue. Bear right at the fork (Kincheloe Road). *1.1 mi*
- Turn left off Kincheloe Road onto Yates Ford Road. *0.8 mi*
- Turn right on Clifton Road. *0.4 mi*
- Turn right on Henderson Road. *0.2 mi*
- Turn right on Old Yates Ford Road. *1.6 mi*
- Turn left onto Davis Ford Road (Rte 663). *2.2 mi*
- Turn left on Prince William Parkway (Rte 3000). *4.7 mi*
- Bear left onto Old Bridge Road (Rte 641). *1.4 mi*
- Turn left onto Tanyard Hill Road. *4.0 mi*

Second Leg Rest Stop

- Along either the Prince William Parkway and Old Bridge Road.

THIRD LEG

- Continue on Tanyard Hill Road as it becomes Union Street entering Occoquon.
- Turn right on Commerce Street (duh, the only option you have). *0.6 mi*
- Take first right at intersection of Washington Street and Occoquon Road. *0.2 mi*
- Follow Occoquon Road to Route 1 (crossing Old Bridge Road and passing under I-66) *1.9 mi*
- Turn north on Route 1.
- Turn right onto Furnace Road (Rte 611) after crossing the bridge. *1.1 mi*
- Follow Furnace Road around sharp right turn.
- Turn left on Old Colchester Road.
- Proceed on Old Colchester Road to Card Stop.

- Continue on Old Colchester Road.
- Turn right on Gunston Road. *2.1 mi*
- Gunston Road will eventually turn into Potomac View Boulevard.
- Continue to end of Potomac View Boulevard. *5.3 mi*
- Turn left on River Drive to Card Stop at the waterfront park.

FIFTH LEG

- Continue on River Drive.
- Turn left on Mallard Road (first left).
- Turn left on Oak Grove Street (first left).
- Join Hollowing Drive by bearing left at the fork.
- Rejoin Gunston Road and continue back to Old Colchester Road.
- Turn right on Old Colchester Road.
- Cross Route 1 at the light. You're now on Telegraph Road. *1.9 mi*
- Continue north on Telegraph Road.
- Bear right onto Kings Highway South (Rte 633). *3.8 mi*
- Follow Kings Highway South until it joins Kings Highway North at Route 1. *1.9 mi*
- Make a hard right turn onto Route 1 south – move to the left lane.
- Turn left at the light opposite Beacon Mall onto Beacon Hill Road. *0.8 mi*
- Continue on Beacon Hill Road (passing Quander Road it turns into Belle View Boulevard).
- Follow Belle View Boulevard eastward to the George Washington Parkway. *1.7 mi*
- Turn right on the Parkway towards Mount Vernon.
- Go past the Mount Vernon traffic circle.
- Turn left at the first light onto Old Mount Vernon Road (Rte 623)
- At sharp right turn the name changes to Old Ferry Landing Road. Stay on this road.
- Turn left on Mount Vernon Memorial Highway.
- Card stop is at Washington's Grist Mill.
